Purpose of using personal data:

IMPROVE is a research & innovation action funded by the EU. In the IMPROVE project's work plan, the collection of stakeholder contacts is foreseen. The stakeholders on the list will be informed via e-mail/newsletter on IMPROVE findings to maximise awareness of the project results. Thus, the purpose of establishing a stakeholder contact list is to be able to contact the persons on the list to a) get feedback on IMPROVE and b) also to inform them about the progress of IMPROVE. Stakeholders in terms of the stakeholder contact list are multipliers for the project findings and also experts in the field of domestic violence. The Stakeholder contact list is confidential and accessible only to the Consortium and the EC Project officer and their experts.

The categories of personal data concerned:

First name, last name, organisational affiliation, expertise, country, and professional e-mail address. The professional e-mail address will be available only to the consortium partners.

The legal justification for processing data:

Article 13 and 14 EU-GDPR.

For how long the data will be kept:

The list containing personal data will be kept for the duration of the project until 30th September 2025.

Recipients of data:

The recipients of the personal data are the members of the IMPROVE Consortium.

Data transfer outside the EU:

No personal data will be transferred to recipients outside the EU (e.g. third countries).

Access to personal data:

The stakeholders on the list have a right to a copy of their personal data as provided in the stakeholder contact list.

Lodging of complaint:

The stakeholders have the right to lodge a complaint with the IMPROVE project's data protection officer.

Withdrawal of consent:

The stakeholders have the right to withdraw their consent at any time. The data will then be removed from the internal list.
